Year 11 Leavers' Assembly, Friday 11 May 2018

The formal Year 11 Leavers' Assembly will take place tomorrow afternoon, Friday 11 May. At 2:20pm, after lesson 4, students should go to the dining room where they will be registered. The assembly will start at 2:30pm in the School Hall and is expected to last approximately 45 – 60 minutes. I would like to take this opportunity to remind students that the usual high standards of behaviour will be expected tomorrow and while they are on the school premises normal school rules will apply. Any student who chooses to behave poorly during the day will be sent home and not permitted to attend the assembly. He / she will also forfeit his / her attendance at the Prom. Full school uniform must be worn at all times and this includes the correct footwear of plain black, polishable leather shoes. If, for any reason, correct school uniform cannot be worn, a letter from parents will need to be provided.

Students always enjoy signing one another's shirts and there will be time to do so after the assembly; however, students should ensure that they bring in a spare shirt for this purpose.

The formal GCSE examinations then commence on Monday 14 May. Students should pay close attention to their individual candidate timetables.
