Dear Student

Now that the examinations have started I wanted to confirm the subject choices for Sixth Form that are available in September and the option blocks that they appear in. In addition I would like to tell you about what the arrangements are for when you receive your results on 23 August.

Sixth Form Options

In terms of the curriculum offer, I have attached the option blocks for next year, showing the groupings of subjects. Option blocks will inevitably have the potential for clashes of choices for a few individuals; if this is something that affects you I would be grateful if you could contact me at the school to discuss the matter. **Please note that a decision has been made to remove French A Level from our offer for next year due to limited numbers.**

Do remember that the majority of students will take three subjects while a minority – if they wish – can study four; students who wish to pursue the latter pathway will need to have achieved a number of the highest grades in their subjects.

Results Day 23 August

Results will be issued from 09.00 a.m. on Thursday 23 August. If you are unable to pick them up personally on the day there are a number of things that you can do:

- Write a letter of authorisation allowing someone else to collect your results
- Provide a stamped addressed envelope to the school so that results can be posted to you
- Pick up your results from the Sixth Form Office on Friday 24 August between 09.00 and 12.00

When you get your results you will need to speak to a member of staff as soon as possible about your application or about what you plan to do if you are not seeking to join the Sixth Form. These interviews should not take long and in most cases will consist of confirming that the choices remain as they appear on the original application or to record details about your intended destination. Where there are complications, every effort will be made to resolve them during the day.

If you are applying, please bear in mind the entry requirements for the relevant courses as this will be crucial to your application. Similarly, students joining Sixth Form who have not achieved a 4 in English Language or Mathematics will be required to take a re-sit course as part of the subjects studied.
