On **Thursday 14 June** our students will be allowed to attend the Merseyside **Higher Education Exhibition** at the University of Liverpool. The regional exhibition brings together all of the major higher education institutions from across the country in order for them to provide information about the courses they offer. In addition, there will be representatives from the business community and other organisations. Students will be authorised for study leave on that day in order to attend. They will be expected to make their own way into Liverpool where they can be registered outside the Students Guild from 9.30 onwards.

In order to make the day a success, it would be helpful if you could familiarise yourself with the maps and schedule provided by the organisers. The exhibition comprises a marketplace and a series of talks covering major subjects.
