## Open Evening – 20 September 2018

As indicated in our Term Dates 2018/19 and my start of term letter, Formby High School will host its annual Open Evening on Thursday 20 September 2018 (6:45pm to 9:00pm) and the school will be closed to all students during the day with the exception of Year 11 students in the morning.

Year 11 will be expected to attend for an enrichment programme to support their GCSE study as follows:

- Students of F, R and Y should attend school from 8:45am – 10:15am
- Students of O, M and B should attend school from 10:30am – 12:00midday

Students will take part in a seminar delivered by Maximise Your Potential, an organisation that supports young people to develop their revision skills and examination technique. During the seminar, they will have a fast moving and multi-media presentation with inspiration from the worlds of business, sport, music and education! Students are allowed to wear their own clothes but must bring their usual equipment (pen, pencils, etc). They should report to the School Hall for a prompt start.

Students in Years 7 to 10 and Sixth Form should not attend school on Thursday 20 September and will return as normal at 8:55am on Friday 21 September.
