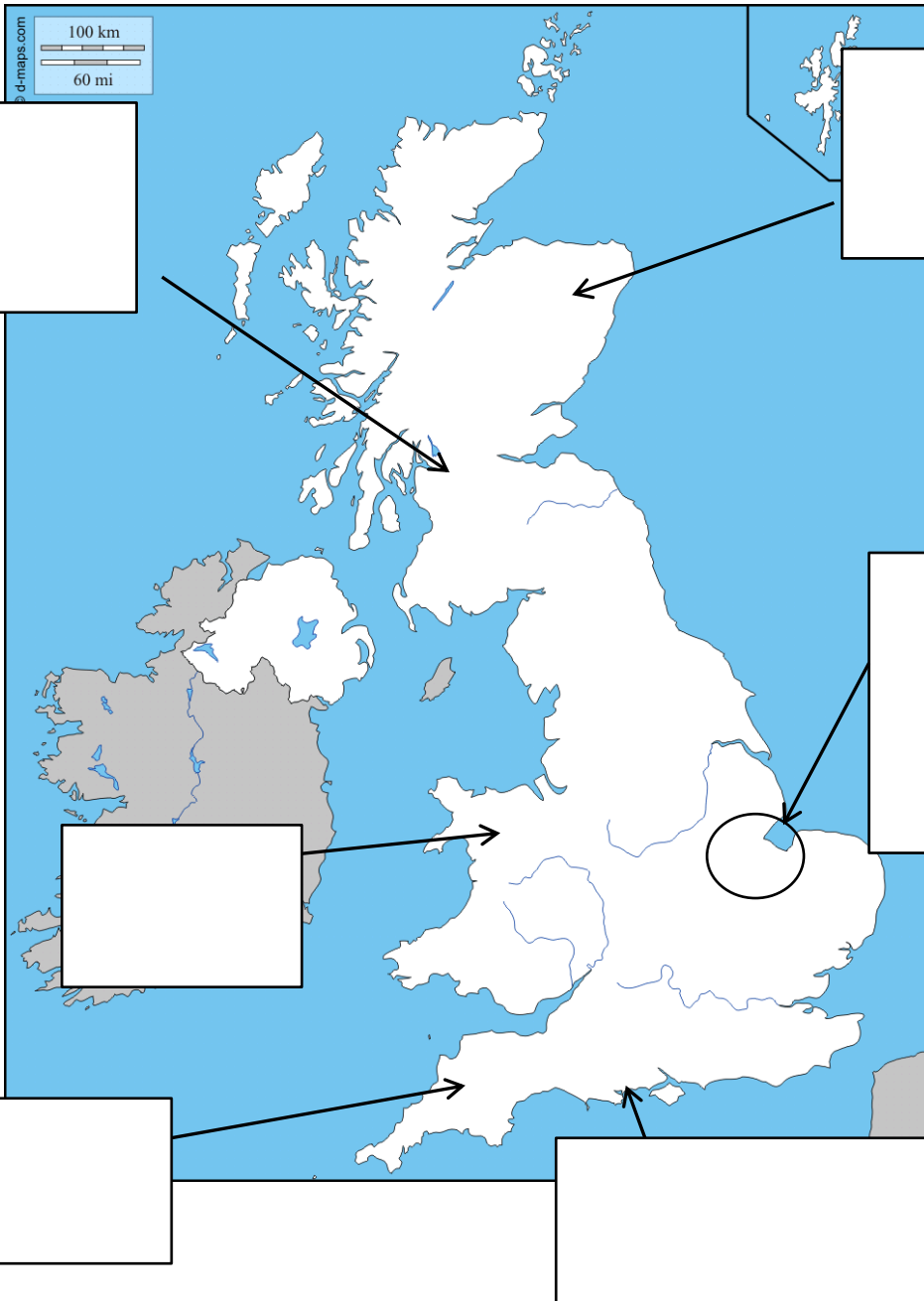


Physical Landscape of the UK
