## Non-Uniform Day in Support of Children in Need – 13 November 2020

In addition to the non-uniform day, there will be a number of other activities to raise funds for this important cause taking place throughout the week, including:

- **Years 7 and 8 Cake Sale** – Friday 13 November at break time. All cakes 50p (correct change only please). Students wishing to bake / donate cakes should drop them off in the dining rooms using the rear entrances as follows:
  - Year 7 in the hot dining room before morning tutor period
  - Year 8 in the cold dining room before Period 1
- **All Years Pudsey Merchandise** – a limited amount of items are available to buy now via ParentPay only, including Pudsey ears £2.50, Pudsey wristbands £1 and Pudsey badges £1. Items will be available for collection from the pastoral office in each year group bubble on Thursday 12 November so that they can be worn during the non-uniform day.
- **All Years Raffle for Giant Pudsey Bear** – tickets (50p each) are now available via ParentPay only. Payments will be assigned a raffle number and the raffle will be drawn and announced on Friday 13 November.

I see a non-uniform day as a privilege and expect all students to attend appropriately and sensibly dressed for the school day. Any student who fails to do so will be sent home from school to change.
