Dear Parent

I wanted to write to you with more detail about what students should be doing after half term. The government has stipulated that Year 11 students should remain engaged in education until 25 June. This should be used as an opportunity for students to prepare for their post-16 pathways with students working either independently via remote learning, through virtual sessions or in face to face events.

We are therefore providing students with 'Weekly Walk Thrus' which will provide a series of activities for your [son/daughter] to work through each week leading up to Friday 25 June. They can be located [here](#); we would encourage you to review them in order to support your child over the coming weeks. Students will be able to access the information on Class Charts and should seek to book in for any virtual or face-to-face sessions in advance.

In short, you will see on the Weekly Walk Thru that students will have:

- Materials to complete for each of their A Level / BTEC subject choices to help bridge the gap ahead of September
- Well-being suggestions, including opportunities to take part in whole year group activities
- Staff recommendations of things to watch, listen to or read
- Careers webinars to engage with on areas relevant to them
- Virtual or face-to-face taster and Q&A sessions staggered across the three weeks
- A 'live' assembly each Tuesday at 1:30pm
- The option to enroll on a training course should they be considering a vocational pathway in September

We will also be providing face-to-face Careers workshops, our annual Sixth Form Taster Afternoon and the Year 11 Celebration Assembly throughout this period.
