Dear Parent

You will be aware from media coverage that the national and local rates of infection of Covid-19, particularly of the delta variant, continue to raise concerns. The school is continuing to manage the impact of positive cases and I would like to acknowledge the tremendous support from parents, students and staff in doing so. I can say with confidence that without this support, the impact and disruption to learning would have been far greater and I am very grateful to everyone involved.

As promised, working closely with the Headteacher of Range High School, we have conducted a weekly review of the situation with regards to face coverings and have decided that we will continue to require their use in school until the end of this academic year. Sefton Local Authority is also advising all secondary schools in the borough to do the same.

I would ask that you continue to support your child in completing twice weekly home tests and ensure that these are reported to the NHS/FHS accordingly. Please remember that home tests are in place to identify any infections that arise without symptoms. Should your child display symptoms, I would ask that you do not send him/her into school and that a PCR test is booked without delay.
