## Year 11 Arrangements

In a normal year, Year 11 students would have their last day and Celebration Assembly on the Friday before GCSE examinations start. Due, however, to changed circumstances around the examination season, we intend on doing things a little differently this year.

The last week of this half term (week commencing Monday 24 May) will see the final round of Year 11 assessments taking place. To help with the completion of these, students in Year 11 should attend all lessons until the end of the day on Tuesday 25 May and then between Wednesday 26 and Friday 28 May they should only attend lessons in which they have an assessment or are being prepared for an assessment. For the remainder of the time students will be on study leave. This will mean that students in Year 11 will have a staggered finish to this half term.

The government would like Year 11 students to remain engaged with learning after the half term break and until Friday 25 June. As such, we will be providing students with a range of tasks to enable them to work remotely between Tuesday 8 June and Friday 25 June. These remote activities will focus on readiness for post-16 pathways and mental health and well-being. In addition to this, students will be given opportunities to take part in a variety of activities in school. 'Weekly Walk Thrus' will provide instructions for each week and will be shared via Class Charts and ParentMail. There are two key events which will take place during this period that I would want to draw your attention to:

- Sixth Form Taster Afternoon (Wednesday 23 June)
- Year 11 Celebration Assembly (afternoon of Friday 25 June)

More specific information about both of these will be shared nearer the time.
