Re: Year 10 Study Leave for Religious Studies Examinations

Further to Mrs Wake's letter about the Religious Studies examinations, I am writing to confirm that students are entitled to a session of study leave prior to their examination dates as follows:

Friday 12 May (prior to the Religious Studies Paper 1 examination on Monday 15 May)

- Tutor groups 10 MBYH students are allowed to go home immediately after their Period 3 lesson.
- Tutor groups 10 FOR students will remain in school until 2:15pm as they have a Religious Studies lesson during Period 4; it is essential that they attend the lesson the help them prepare for the examination.

Tuesday 23 May (prior to the Religious Studies Paper 2 examination that afternoon)

 All students sitting the Religious Studies examinations are also entitled to study leave on the morning of Tuesday 23 May and should arrive promptly to the exam room (1:15pm) for their afternoon examination.

Students should inform the Attendance Office if they intend to remain in school to revise independently. Alternative arrangements will be made for any students not sitting the Religious Studies examination and communicated separately.
