Dear Parent

As the end of the school year approaches, I am writing to provide you with information about arrangements for the end of term and other important updates.

End of Term Arrangements

The last week of term will be a busy one as usual, please note the arrangements below:

Monday 17 July (Sports Day)

There will be an INSET session between 8:45am-11:00am for staff only and students should arrive promptly to school at 11:10am, ready for a tutor period at 11:15am in their form room. All students should arrive in school in their PE kit for Sports Day which will take place in the afternoon (with some field events in late morning). Please ensure your son/daughter brings a refillable water bottle in the event of warmer weather. You may wish to advise your child to bring along some spare change as there will be a tuck shop to raise funds for the Borneo trip in operation on Sports Day.

Tuesday 18 July

Tuesday is a normal school day for Years 7-10 and 12 with lessons as usual.

Wednesday 19 July (Rewards Trips Day)

After a year of hard work, rewards trips will be taking place on Wednesday for those students who have signed up and separate communications have been sent with arrangements for the day. Students remaining in school should attend in PE kit and will be required to arrive for 8:50am and report to the Dining Room where they will be registered.

Thursday 20 July

For the last day of term, students should arrive at the usual time in full school uniform. They will have an extended session with their tutor group before morning break. This will be followed by the end of year celebration assembly in the Sports Hall after which students will be dismissed from school (at approximately midday).

Lockers

Any students who are currently using a school locker must ensure that it is empty and the padlock removed by the end of the school day on Tuesday 18 July 2023. Any contents/padlocks remaining will be removed during the summer holiday to enable lockers to be cleaned.

Merseyrail

We have been asked by Merseyrail to share with students and their parents that, as a result of changes across the national rail network, they will be increasing fines for those travel on their trains without a ticket from 17 July 2023. More information can be found at this <u>link</u>.

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Uniform and PE Kit

I would like to remind parents that the school's uniform expectations can be found in the <u>School Uniform</u> section of the school website and would ask that any purchases made for the new school year comply with these expectations. You will recall that a new, more cost effective PE kit was introduced in September 2022 and this year has been a year of transition from old to new. As mentioned in our recent newsletter, we would welcome any donations of pre-loved uniform or old-style PE kit to a special charity project – supporting the <u>Olmalaika</u> <u>Trust</u> based in the Masai Mara area of Kenya and other Kenyan primary and secondary schools (with a combined intake of 1500 children) for boys and girls in the same region. Donations can be made at our main Reception on Tuesday 18, Wednesday 19 and Thursday 20 July (we respectfully ask that all items are washed!).

Summer Showcase


