## School Procedures - Disruption/Closure due to Bad Weather Conditions

You may be aware from recent weather forecasts that we are due for a period of very cold weather with potential for snow in the next 24 to 48 hours. In the event of snow, we will attempt to do whatever we can to ensure the school remains open. It may, however, in the interests of safety of students and staff, be necessary to either delay start time, partially close or close. If such action is necessary, the school will ensure the following:

- announcements will be posted on the school website ([www.formbyhighschool.com](http://www.formbyhighschool.com)) and I ask that parents check the website on a regular basis.
- text messages/emails will be sent via IRIS ParentMail to all parents with full closure information. Further updates will also be communicated via this method. I encourage all parents to ensure they are registered with this service and receiving school correspondence. If you have not registered for IRIS ParentMail, please contact the school office (01704 873100) for information on how to do so.
- Students will receive information via Class Charts announcements.
- Local media (Liverpool Echo, Formby Bubble) will also be informed of any disruption to the school day.

We will continue to monitor forecast conditions and any disruption to normal school operations (where appropriate) will be communicated via the above channels.
