Year 9 Online Options Interview – Wednesday 21 February 2024

We would like to invite you to attend our Online Options Interview for Year 9 on Wednesday 21 February (4:30pm to 7:30pm). During the meeting, the relevant teacher will discuss suggested pathways, the GCSE and vocational courses open to your son /daughter, and any other pertinent issues. The meeting will be slightly longer in duration than the individual subject consultations. The teaching staff members involved are detailed at the end of this letter.

As the appointment will be held via video you will require access to a device with a webcam, microphone, speaker, and a compatible web browser (Safari, Chrome, or Firefox). A smartphone with a front-facing camera or a laptop with a webcam will be suitable. We have been advised by our software provider that you may experience audio difficulties using an Apple device. Therefore, it is recommended that Apple devices running iOS 14.2 are not used to access appointments.

Booking the appointment

The method of booking the appointment is like the usual process you would follow for the Subject Consultation Evening(s). To access the online booking system, please use the following link (<https://formbyhighschool.schoolcloud.co.uk/>) or visit our website and click on the 'Parents' Evenings' link at the bottom of the page. You will be required to login with the following information:

Student's Surname

Student's Date of Birth (dd/mm/yyyy)

You will be able to choose your own appointment time with the teacher to which you are assigned, and you will receive an email confirming your appointment. **The appointment may be booked from 7:00pm on Tuesday 6 February until 10:00am on Monday 19 February.** Should you wish to make any changes after this date, please contact Mrs Haughey by email at e.haughey@formbyhighschool.com.

Your appointment will be automatically confirmed via the email address that you have provided to the school. If it does not appear in your inbox, please check it has not been sent to your 'Spam' folder.

Accessing Video Appointments

To access your video appointment on the evening itself, please login to Parents' Evening System at the usual web address (<https://formbyhighschool.schoolcloud.co.uk/>). You will be advised that you have an upcoming video appointment and a 'Join Video Appointments' button will become available 60 minutes before your scheduled interview. The interview will be **eight minutes** in length and a countdown clock will be visible to both you and the teacher during your interview. Please note that there will be no facility to extend the interview beyond the allotted time and the



meeting will end automatically at the end of the scheduled appointment. You will only be able to join the interview by clicking on the 'Start Appointment' button. Detailed instructions on how to access your interview can be found [here](#).

If you require additional time to discuss the matter, please arrange an alternative meeting / telephone conversation during the interview. Students are expected to attend the interview with you as they are, of course, central to the options decision-making process.
